## How To Play Player Pair and Banker Pair

Place a wager on the Player Pair and Banker Pair which complies with the betting limits at the table.


If the first two cards dealt to the Banker's hand and/or the Player's hand are the same type\* and value the Pair wager wins.

Winning wagers on Player Pair and Banker Pair are paid 11 to 1.

\*10, Jack, Queen and King are identical in value but not in type, therefore a Jack and King, for example, would not be considered as a pair.

# HOW TO PLAY Baccarat







### **How To Play Baccarat**

Baccarat, also known as Punto Banco, is similar to the game of Chemin de Fer. Baccarat is one of the easiest games to play and is widely played throughout the world.

To play Baccarat you only need to decide where to place your bet: on the 'Banker's Hand', the 'Player's Hand' or on the 'Tie Bet' before the cards are dealt. All decisions pertaining to the game are made by the dealer in accordance with the rules.

Baccarat is played with eight decks of cards. The cards are shuffled by the dealer and placed in the Baccarat 'Shoe'.

Play begins with four cards dealt from the shoe by the dealer. First card to the 'Player's Hand', second to the 'Banker's Hand', third to the 'Player's Hand' and fourth to the 'Banker's Hand'.

You may bet on either hand. One additional card may be dealt to each hand in accordance with the table of play (tableau).

The hand with the highest point count wins. Picture cards and tens count as zero.

- Winning bets on the 'Player's Hand' are paid at even money.
- Winning bets on the "Banker's Hand" are paid 19 to 20 (This does not apply to No Commission Baccarat)

In Baccarat, face cards and ten cards have no value, all other cards have their face value and the first digit of any total greater than nine is discounted.

Therefore the highest count possible is 9. For example, 2 plus 7 equals 9, 10 plus King equals 0, 6 plus 8 equals 4. If both hands result in the same point value it is a Tie hand (Egalite) and neither hand wins nor loses.

#### **How to Play Super 6**

Place a wager on the Bankers hand which complies with the betting limits at the table.

If the Bankers hand point count is 6 the wager wins. If the Bankers hand point count is not 6, or the Players hand wins or the result is a Tie the wager loses.

Winning wagers on Super 6 are paid at 15 to 1.

#### **No Commission Baccarat**

All winning wagers on player and banker are paid at the odds on 1 to 1 (even money) with one exception. When the banker's hand wins with a total of six, all winning banker bets are paid at the odds of 1 to 2. The dealer will announce, "Bank wins".

The house margin for Baccarat is around 1.3%
